

Courchevel, the famous French ski resort, and Park City have been Sister Cities since 1984. Due to this relationship, many students have been lucky enough to participate in cultural and linguistic exchanges, forming lasting memories and building life-long friendships. During 2020 our students from the Park City area will again have opportunity to participate in the Winter/Summer exchange. **This exchange is "Total Immersion," with our students staying individually with** their host families.

Program Dates. This exchange is in two parts; dates are approximate.

- Feb 14-23. Park City youth travel to Courchevel, staying with their French hosts. These dates are normally during the PC Winter break.
- July 20-31. Courchevel Students travel to Utah, staying with their Park City hosts.

Program Costs per student:

- Approximately \$2200, depending on airfare. Limited scholarship funding may be available.
- Some of the optional summer activities in Utah will incur additional cost, depending on the activity (i.e. Lagoon).

Eligibility for this Exchange Program:

- This program is an exchange between Sister Cities, and as such any students that live in the greater Park City area (or attend Park City High School) are welcome to apply for participation. This program is not limited to Park City High students.
- Students must be high school students.
- Students must be 15-18 years old during the exchange.
- Each student is required to have a Passport that will be valid for at least three months after the completion of the travel to France

Students (and their Parents) agree to participate in all aspects of the program, including, but not limited to:

• Being outstanding ambassadors for Park City

- Attending required meetings and meeting program timelines
- Paying required fees on time
- Providing signed releases and waivers
- Providing a safe and hygienic home when hosting a French student

Program Considerations and Student Selection:

- There are a limited number of student positions for this exchange
- The committee will review student applications and select the most qualified students.
- Any student can apply. Priority will be given to students who have familiarity with the French Language, having studied French or spoken French at home.
- Physical fitness. This French portion of this program consists of athletic activities such as skiing, ice climbing, skating and hiking. Lessons and equipment are available if you are a beginner. The French will teach you.
